

1. The **Prince Albert SaskTel Pioneer's**, a volunteer organization of current and former SaskTel employees topped up donations made by the PA Pioneers

The "**Prince Albert Safe Shelter for Women**" pride themselves on the feeling of safety they're able to provide.

Only between nine and 10 per cent of women who experience domestic violence seek shelter assistance, representing a significant number of people who don't feel safe in their own home. Women and children typically come to the shelter with nothing -- a significant gap of clothing, toys, bedding, personal care and household items that donors help fill.

The Prince Albert Safe Shelter for Women is charged with providing that sense of safety these women and children have been missing out on.

Staffed 24/7, the facility has 32 video surveillance cameras inside and out and a locked and monitored front door that doesn't open unless someone inside gives it the go-ahead.
